

European Regulation on chemicals and their safe use – REACH

Hub Electronics Ltd do not directly manufacture, but products stocked and distributed are classified as not intended to release substances under normal conditions of use, and as such we are not directly required to register materials used in their manufacture. However, we do recognise that the REACH regulation requires us to communicate with our supply chain in order to ensure our products are compliant.

We are actively working with our direct suppliers to ensure that they understand their obligations under REACH and the need to work with their supply chain to ensure that they have pre-registered any affected substances and preparations. Additionally, we are reviewing our supply chain to ensure we can meet any forward communication obligations to our customer base.

We are working with our supplier base to ensure that these additions are assessed and met together with updates as appropriate against individual supplier records.

RoHS & REACH preferred supplier statements/policies are held electronically against each supplier record and updated regularly along with WEEE and conflict Minerals database as required.

We continue to request that all preferred Hub suppliers & manufacturers supply to the latest REACH requirements and update us accordingly as part of supplier record maintenance. HUB will duly inform customers (upon request) about products registered under the requirement as declared to us. We will continue to act on latest obligations under this directive in partnership with direct manufacturers and suppliers as required.
